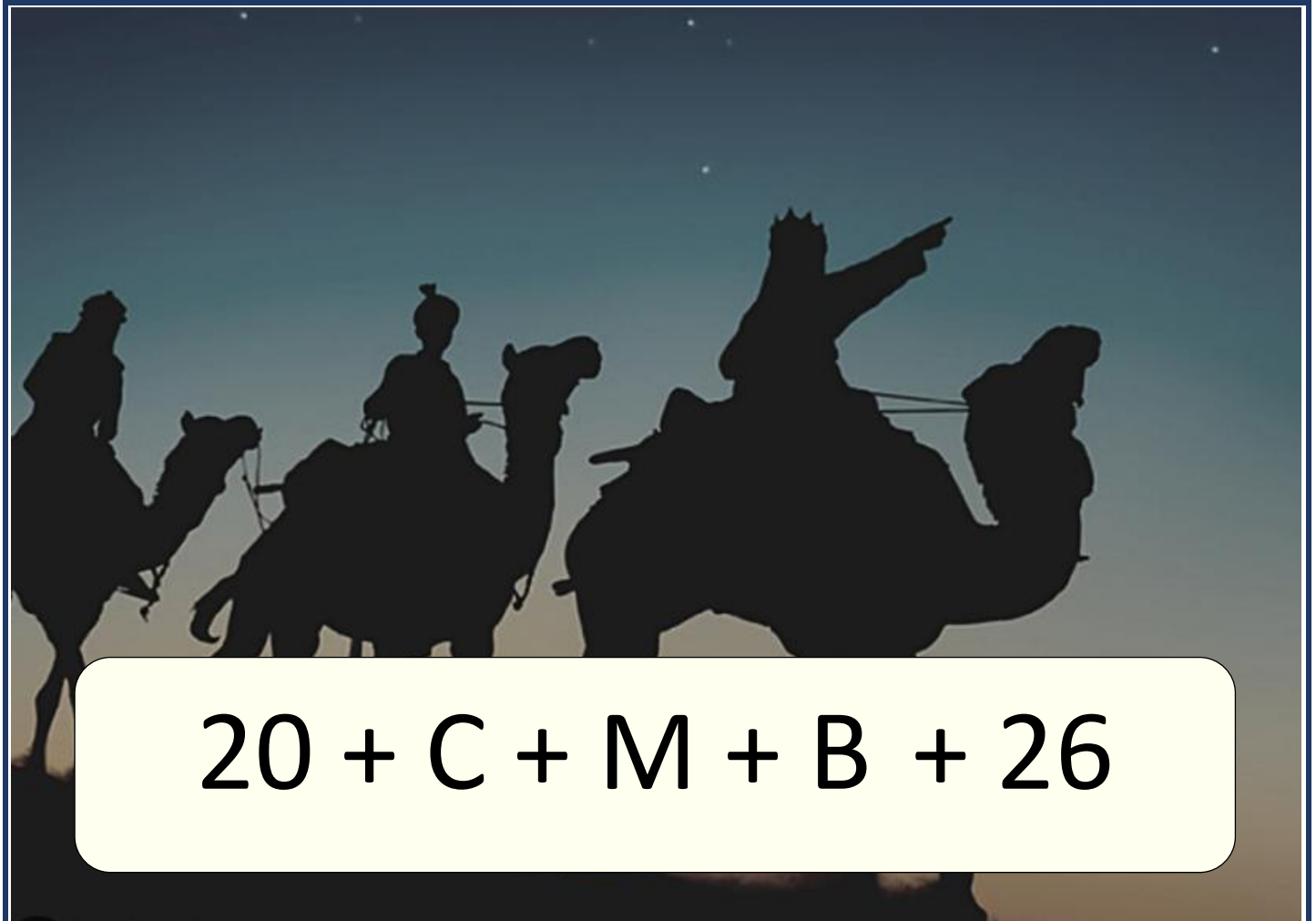


Benefice Notices for the Festival of The Baptism of Christ - Sunday 11th January 2026

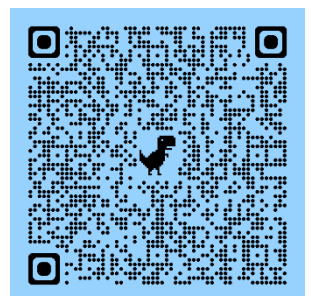
