All Saints' Church Cleaning: *This* Thurs. (29th), from 11am - 1pm. Please bring dusters, cobweb brushes, gloves etc.

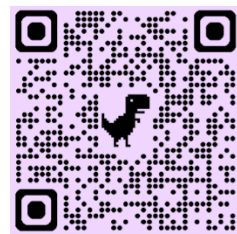

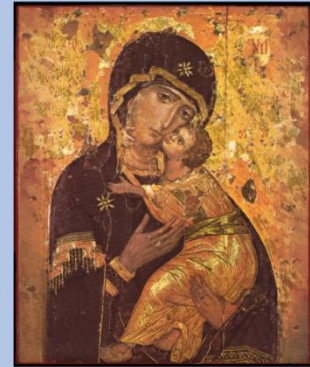
